

RFI MEETING

This virtual meeting is organized by the Frequency Allocations In Remote Sensing Technical Committee (FARS-TC) <http://www.grss-ieee.org/community/technical-committees/frequency-allocations-in-remote-sensing/> with the kind support of the MicroRad 2020 Symposium organizers.

The focus will be on two topics:

1. Dr. Bevin Ashley Zauderer, Program Director for Electromagnetic Spectrum Management at the US National Science Foundation (NSF), will give a presentation on the NSF Spectrum Innovation Initiative for a National Center for Wireless Spectrum Research, followed by a Q&A and discussion;
2. Introduction of a proposal for development of standards to assess the “quality” of remote sensing frequency bands in terms of amount of man-made Radio Frequency Interference (RFI), with the goal of collecting feedback from our members and form a working group.
